
Black History Month

4. Who am I quiz: Try and work out the identity of the following inspirational black people. How many can you get right?

a. I was born and raised in Philadelphia. I started out as an actor but then moved into singing. Now, I am not just famous for my singing and acting, but also for producing films and writing songs for other artists. I have been nominated for Golden Globes, Academy Awards and Grammies. I am the star of movie franchises like Men in Black and Bad Boys.

b. I was born long ago in 1913 in Alabama. In 1955, I refused to give up my seat on a public bus to a white person; I was arrested for this and fined \$10 (the equivalent of £75 in today's money). This incident sparked the "Montgomery Bus Boycott", which caused greater awareness of racial segregation and racism, and saw many rules and laws repelled. I later became known as "the mother of the civil rights movement". **Who am I?**

c. I was born in 1929 in Georgia in the USA. My father was a pastor in a Baptist Church, and he stood up against racial discrimination and segregation. I led the Montgomery Bus Boycott. I was heavily influenced by Mahatma Gandhi's teachings of non-violence and helped to organise nonviolent protests, marches and sit-ins. I delivered my famous 'I have a dream' speech in 1963. After I was fatally shot by James Earl Ray, President Johnson declared a National Day of Mourning. **Who am I?**

d. I am a black Briton and a sportsman. I started go-kart racing at eight years old. I was the first black racing driver to race in Formula 1. I now have more wins than any other driver in Formula 1 and I was the first person ever to reach 100 race wins in the sport. I am the first black Formula 1 world champion. **Who am I?**



e. I was born in Hawaii in 1961. I moved to Indonesia when I was four years old. I moved back to America when I was ten. In 1991, I graduated from Harvard Law School. In 2009, I earned the Nobel Peace Prize. In January 2009, I was officially inaugurated as the President of the USA. **Who am I?**
